# **Background**

It was noted at the HMCCC's October 2024 meeting that the appointments of Rikki Parkinson, Margaret Roads and Tim Walsh were due to expire in February 2025.

As per the HMCCC's Terms of Reference the meeting established an appointments sub-committee comprising Phil Tyler (HMCCC, Chair), Mark Butterworth (HMCCC Rex member) and Don Hosking (HMCCC member) to report and make recommendations to the HMCCC December 2024 meeting on the appointments to come into effect February 2025.

It was noted at the meeting that the new appointments are for a 3-year term and the current members are eligible to apply for reappointment.

#### General

On 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 the Chair of HMCCC wrote to the 3 members whose appointments were expiring asking if they were interested in being considered for a new 3-year term, commencing February 2025. The Chair received positive responses from all 3 members.

The appointments sub-committee has considered the membership and was unanimous that the following members brought considerable knowledge and experience in the following areas:

Rikki Parkinson: business and community.

Margaret Roads: Education (Principal, Ardrossan Area School) and local community.

**Tim Walsh:** working with Aboriginal communities and people with disabilities.

### Summary

The sub-committee's view was that these members have made significant contributions and brought a blend of knowledge, skills and experience that complemented the work of the HMCCC.

# Recommendation

That Rikki Parkinson, Margaret Roads and Tim Walsh be reappointed to the Hillside Mine Community Consultative Committee for a 3-year term commencing February 2025.
